## **GBEW Network Community Group – Team Leader**

**ROLE CONTEXT**: The Girls' Brigade is a Christian organisation whose aim is 'To help girls to become followers of the Lord Jesus Christ and through self-control, reverence and a sense of responsibility to find true enrichment of life.'

It is expected that Team Leaders should have an active faith and represent the aims and values of the Girls' Brigade whilst carrying out their duties.

**ROLE TITLE: TEAM LEADER** 

**TRAINING**: In addition to all **n:fluence 18+** training modules, **n:fluence 18+** Team Leader module must also be completed by those wishing to be appointed as a Team Leader. Topics included in this additional module are:

- Leading a team
- Organisation and administration
- Networking

GB's *Life to the Full* safeguarding training must also be completed.

**RESPONSIBLE TO**: Church to which the group belongs/District team

**RESPONSIBLE FOR**: Leading and coordinating volunteers within the local GB Community Group

**Role of Team Leader**: To coordinate volunteers to deliver weekly group activities, trips and events including residentials and sleepovers for (primarily) girls and young women

## **Role description**

The role will include, but not be limited to,:

- Planning and delivering GB group activities to young people in a relevant and relational way
- Overseeing the delivery of activities and development of children, young people and volunteers
- Making regular contact with all sections of the group and organising regular meetings of volunteers
- Managing and, where necessary, delegating administrative tasks to volunteers in the group
- Using or, where appropriate, delegating the administration of GB Manager
- Planning and supervising additional events and outings such as sleepovers or Residential Events

- Providing a safe environment for young people to explore faith and develop spiritually
- Communicating regularly with District Team Leader and Church Leadership/Minister/Chaplain
- Consciously thinking about succession planning for your group
- Regularly using the Group Wellbeing Toolkit to monitor and evaluate your group
- Following the Code of Conduct for Volunteers and operate within the policies as set out within Girls' Brigade Ministries' *Life to the Full*.

## **Role requirements**

Team Leaders should:

- Complete n:fluence 18+ training as detailed above, including the Team Leader module and Life to the Full safeguarding training
- Have an up-to-date DBS, as specified by GBEW
- Complete the Volunteer Registration Form and send it to the GB Support Centre.

Please note: Some volunteers may need to be a church member if stipulated by the church your GB group belongs to.
