# Responsibilities of Network Executive Members

The Network Executive plays an important role in the leadership of our mission and has oversight of our uniformed youth work across England & Wales. Members of the Network Executive report to The Girls' Brigade England and Wales board of trustees.

The role of a member of the Network Executive is to:

- Champion our Christian values and the Girls' Brigade's values
- Speak well of The Girls' Brigade, both internally and externally
- Exercise oversight of the uniformed youth work by considering information provided by the Support Centre and making suggestions for ongoing development and improvement of the Groups and Districts
- Support allocated Districts and Groups to complete their respective Wellbeing Toolkits (Health checks) to identify problems and issues at an early opportunity so that the appropriate action can be taken to ensure that groups thrive and are sustainable
- Encourage Groups to keep their safeguarding and compliance is up-to-date and raise any concerns with the Support Centre
- Encourage Groups and Districts to participate in the annual Fundraising Challenge so that they have the necessary resources to thrive and grow
- Willingness to devote the necessary time and effort in order to carry out fully the tasks and responsibilities of a Network Executive member
- Commitment to adhering to the Nolan seven principles of public life: selflessness, integrity, objectivity, accountability, openness, honesty and leadership.
