### Monday

### Tuesday

## Wednesday

**Growth** - The new year is a great time to celebrate how far you've come in the last 12 months. Ask God for guidance in how you can grow in 2025 too.

## Thursday

**Opportunities in 2025** - Pray that in the coming year, there will be more opportunities for Girls' Brigade as an organisation - for opportunities for our young people, for funding, and for times that we can come together to share.

## Friday

**Healthy minds** - Kick the January blues and pray for God to fill your mind with words of affirmation to remind yourself that He's the light in the darkness.

## Saturday

**Esther Generation Weekend** - Keep in your prayers the staff and volunteers putting plans together for the Esther Generation Weekend and the young people as they prepare to attend and any worries they may have in the run-up.

## Sunday

**Love** - Ask for God's help in remembering that the most important things are not what we do outwardly, but are to love Him and to choose to love others as He commanded.
